Dialing 711 will connect you to Relay Hawaii, a no-cost service, which allows effortless communication with people who are deaf, hard-of-hearing, deafblind, speech-disabled, or hearing.

It is very simple to make a phone call. Just:

- 1) Dial **7-1-1*** or use these toll-free numbers listed below.
- 2) Give the relay operator the number of the person you are calling.
- 3) Easily communicate - an operator will relay the message between you and the other person.
